
COLUMBIA MILITARY ACADEMY SCHOLARSHIP


MR. AND MISS COLUMBIA ACADEMY

New York City, 1899. Jack Kelly (Rhett Dupree) and his ragtag team of newsboys make a meager living selling newspapers on the city streets. But when the prices of "papes" are hiked and the newsies are hung out to dry, there is nothing left to do but "open the gates and seize the day!" Led by charismatic Jack, a smart and level-headed Davey (Will Sowell) and independent, young newspaper reporter Katherine Plummer (Anna Kate Cofer), the Newsies form a union and organize a strike against the greedy publisher of the New York World, Joseph Pulitzer (Frazier Isenberg).

> Inspired by the true story of the 1899 Newsboys Strike, Newsies is an ebullient, joyful, and entertaining musical capturing the strength that young people have when they join together and stand up against injustice. Fifty-four students and five faculty members returned to the Cherry Theatre in March to tackle this monumental musical. They leveled up their game by creating a dance spectacle not seen before on the CA stage. The show was student directed by Emma Walker and choreographed by student Lilly Baum and Christina Baum.







BASEBALL - STATE CHAMPIONS

The 2024 baseball team won the DII-A state championship defeating Providence Academy 9-4. The team finished with a 37-6 record, which is the most wins in school history. This is the first baseball title in Division II and third overall. The team was District 3 Co-Champions, Region Champions, and State Champions. The team won ten games in a row, outscoring their opponents 45-20. Gunner Skelton was a Mr. Baseball Finalist. C.J. Durrough, Andy Reed, and Jacob Woodward were on the All-District Team, and Gunner Skelton was the District Player of the Year.

TRACK AND FIELD, BOYS - INDIVIDUAL STATE CHAMPIONS

The boys team had its best season ever in program history! Seven school records were broken on the boys' side. The 100m was broken by junior Jeremy Jackson, 400m by junior C.J. Barr, 110m hurdles by senior Griffin Cooper as well as the triple jump. Zane Nash broke the pole vault record and records were broken in the 4 x 100m relay (Jeremy Jackson, Montae Baldwin, Harrison Brownlee, and Andre McClellan) and the 4 x 200m relay (Jeremy Jackson, Montae Baldwin, Harrison Brownlee, and C.J. Barr). The boys were regional runner-ups for the second year in a row and were led by regional champion C.J. Barr in the 3200m, 4 x 200m relay, 800m, and 1600m. Griffin Cooper won the high jump and the boys 4 x 200m relay were regional champions as well. At the TSSAA DII-A State Championship, Griffin Cooper won his third in a row high jump state championship and followed it up by winning the triple jump state championship as well!! C.J. Barr earned a state runner-up in the 1600m and sophomore Ty Withrow earned state runner-up honors in the 3200m! Both the 4 x 100m relay team (Jeremy Jackson, Montae Baldwin, Harrison Brownlee, and Andre McClellan) and the 4 x 200m relay team (Jeremy Jackson, Montae Baldwin, Harrison Brownlee, and C.J. Barr) placed 3rd at the state championship. Ty Withrow placed 5th in the 1600m, Jeremy Jackson 4th in 200m, and C.J. Barr 5th in the 800m. All athletes earned All-State honors. The boys placed 3rd out of 27 teams!

CROSS COUNTRY, BOYS - **STATE CHAMPIONS**

The boys cross country team had an amazing year. After winning the Randolph Invitational in Alabama, the team raced in the regional championship on October 24, 2023 and WON their first ever middle-regional championship! Ty Withrow was regional champion, followed by runner-up Gabriel Karkau, and 3rd place went to CJ Barr. Josh Lofton finished 5th and Luke Tatum finished 10th. All five Bulldog scorers were named all-region!

On November 2, 2023 the boys team competed at the TSSAA State Championship located at Sanders Ferry Park in Hendersonville, Tenn. The seven runners for the boys varsity team were Ty Withrow, Gabriel Karkau, Josh Lofton, CJ Barr, Luke Tatum, Jayden Brooks and Hutson Cofer. At the state championship, the boys team was led by sophomore Ty Withrow who ran 16:47.87 and was the TSSAA State Runner-Up. Ty was followed by fellow teammate sophomore Gabriel Karkau who finished 4th in a time of 16:57.28 and junior Josh Lofton running in 5th place in 16:57.61. Junior CJ Barr finished 7th in 17:00.53. Finishing out the top five scorers was junior Luke Tatum who ran a personal record of 17:31.53. Freshman Jayden Brooks and freshman Hutson Cofer finished out the varsity team's seven runners. The Bulldogs finished with 31 points and won their FIRST EVER TSSAA DII-A State Championship by a margin of victory of 45 points over University School of Nashville! Their combined time of 17:02 was the second fastest combined time in DII-A state championship history. To add icing on the cake, Ty Withrow, Gabriel Karkau, Josh Lofton, and CJ Barr were also honored with being named to the TSSAA ALL-STATE Team! Congratulations boys on an amazing season. Coach Brady Henson was named Coach of the Year by The Tennessean.

SWIM

This year we had 23 swimmers - four high schoolers and 19 middle schoolers - and of those, 11 were new to the team! This was the largest team in the school's history. Eight swimmers qualified and competed in multiple events at the MTHSSA Middle School Championship. The future of this growing program is very bright!



TENNIS, BOYS

The boys team finished with a record of 10-4 just barely missing the region tournament. The boys only had one senior and will return seven players for next year! Hayes Lewis and Matthew Thomas finished as runner-up in the individual doubles tournament for both district and region!! They qualified for the state tournament and finished in the top eight in the state!





TENNIS, GIRLS

The girls tennis teams finished with a record of 5-9 playing against some very tough teams and some of the top players in the state! They only had one senior so they will return eight players for next year!





BOWLING

The CA Bowling Bulldogs had another amazing season! Bulldogs finished the season with a 14-3 record. CA finished in a 3-way tie for first in the region and finished runner-up in the state tournament. The team made it to back-to-back state tournament appearances. CA also had two bowlers qualify for the individual state tournament (Nathan Hutto and Knox Ransom). Nathan Hutto was the second CA bowler to bowl a perfect 300 game during the season. It was an amazing accomplishment to make back-to-back state tournament appearances and the future keeps looking bright!

SOFTBALL

The softball girls are incredibly talented and all contributed to the team in their own unique way. They won the district tournament this year and competed against lots of great competition outside of their district as well. We are looking forward to all that they will accomplish in the future!



BASKETBALL, BOYS

This season was a historic one for the boys varsity basketball team. Led by seniors Andre McClellan and Griffin Cooper, the Bulldogs finished 26-6 and made it to the state tournament for the first time since joining TSSAA DII. The Bulldogs accomplished several accolades as a team. They finished 2nd in the district regular season, were District Tournament Champions, finished 3rd in the regional tournament, lost in the Elite 8 to the eventual state champions First Assembly Christian School by 1 point, and finished the season ranked #3 in the Tenn. state polls. Along with many team accomplishments, several Bulldogs received individual honors. Senior Andre McClellan committed to play basketball at Bethel University and participated in the BCAT Senior Showcase game; senior Griffin Cooper committed to play basketball at the University of Alabama-Huntsville, scored his 1,000th point, made the all-district team, district tournament team, BCAT All-State, and was selected to BCAT Senior Showcase game; junior Gabe Davenport scored his 1,000th point and made the alldistrict team; junior Jeremy Jackson scored his 1,000th point, made the all-district team, all-region team, district tournament MVP, BCAT All-State, and Tennessee Sports Writers Association All-State Team. The Bulldogs are excited about next season and having continued





CHEER

The CA cheer teams had a fun football, basketball and competition seasons! The varsity competition teams competed in the traditional and game day divisions this year with the traditional team taking home third place at the TSSAA cheer competition in November. The varsity traditional and game day teams ended their season at the UCA National Cheerleading Championship held at Disney World in February. The junior high competition team competed in the game day division and ended their season in December at the UCA Smoky Mountain Championship held in Sevierville.



BASKETBALL, GIRLS

The Lady Bulldogs finished the season with a 10–14 overall record. They were led in the season by all-district players, sophomores Reese Shirley (15.2 ppg) and Haley Collins (12.2 ppg). They also saw the emergence of 8th grader Charley Rae Hutchison (10 ppg). The team will miss the lone senior Ally Ballard, but is excited to see what the future holds for the Lady Bulldogs.



GUNDAWGS

The Gundawgs had a great season! The team brought home twelve team and squad trophies at the State Championship along with ten individual shooter awards. A group of our shooters traveled to the AIM Nationals in Sparta, Illinois July 24-30. There, the team brought home two national team trophies and some Individual awards as well. The competition level was higher overall this year, and they participated in several 18 hole invitational events, as opposed to a more traditional 9 hole match schedule. The teams are working to be better prepared for the district tournament in October. The boys saw great success about midway through the season and won their first 18 hole invitational, the Tennessee River Classic held on the River Course in Decaturville, Tenn., defeating 11 other schools. The girls continued to improve during the season. Jay Coleman advanced for the first time to the regional round of competition and turned in a respectable 81 at Graystone in Dickson. The 2024 boys team will return all five starters and the girls team is looking to rebuild with one of the three girls returning. Many thanks to the leadership of this year's seniors: Addyson Codling, Amelia Briceno, Isaac Smith, Ian Million, and Rhett Dupree.



CROSS COUNTRY, GIRLS

On October 24 the girls cross country team advanced to the TSSAA State Championship by placing 3rd at the DII-A Middle Region. Janie Reames was meet runner-up, and Emma Rees placed 10th, and Presley Miller 12th. All three girls were named to the TSSAA All-Region team. On November 2, 2023 the girls team competed at the TSSAA State Championship located at Sanders Ferry Park in Hendersonville. The seven runners for the girls team were Janie Reames, Presley Miller, Emma Rees, Mackenzie Reames, Charley Hutchison, Braelyn Henry, and Emma Bookout. They were led by freshman Janie Reames who ran 19:46.85 and was the TSSAA State Runner-Up. Janie was followed by fellow teammate junior, Presley Miller who finished in a time of 19:49.53 and placed 3rd in the meet. Freshman Emma Rees ran 20:33.39 and placed 9th for the Bulldogs giving Columbia Academy three girls in the top 10. Other notable scorers for the team were junior Mackenzie Reames and 8th grader Charley Hutchison. The Lady Bulldogs tied for 2nd with 74 points and were then moved to 3rd place after the tiebreaker. This marks the highest finish by any Bulldog girls cross country championship. Janie Reames, Presley Miller, and Emma Rees were also recognized as TSSAA All-State Runners for Division II-A. Congratulations to these girls on their amazing achievement.



The soccer team encountered a setback in the second round of the regional tournament this year, echoing the previous season's outcome. Notably, the team achieved a distinctive overall record of 8-8-1, showcasing an impressive improvement.



The addition of new and youthful

talent, including four freshmen, four 8th graders (promoted due to roster constraints), and three transfer girls, contributed significantly. Seasoned players Kelsey Cordero, Elizabeth Gaines, and Emily Diles served as wonderful leaders. Individual achievements included: Rebecca Goodwin as the leading goal scorer and assist maker with 12 goals and nine assists, Carolina Johnson scoring 11 goals, and 8th grader Marley Ayers contributing 10 goals. Hope Massey, our goal keeper, was astonishing. She was an 8th grader and played as though she were an upperclassman.

"The team's collective effort, resilience in the face of challenges, and a welcoming team culture made coaching them an honor," says Coach Ellie Butterfield.

As we look forward to the next year, the phrase "Handle Hard Better" encapsulates their spirit and determination.

The team finished the season 8-4 and won the region title for the first time since 2017! This was the first DII region title for Columbia Academy. The team advanced to the semi-finals for the third time in school history and first time since 2017. Montae Baldwin broke the school's single season rushing and TD record with 1,955 rushing yards and 27 TD's. Seven teammates were named to the All-State Team: Connor Rosson, Cade Jackson, C.J. Durrough, Montae Baldwin, Harrison Brownlee, Daniel Cepicky, and Gabriel Cepicky.

The girls finished 11th out of 29 teams with their highest finish ever!



In the RoboDawgs robotics program, upper school students flex their creative muscles by designing, building, and programming robots for yearly challenges. With VEX Robotics, students are challenged to make their robots move stuff into goals, shoot disks into baskets, and hang on structures in the playing field.

Throughout the year, varsity and junior high teams kick things off by brainstorming strategies to rack up the most points in matches. 
JASON DELK ('94)





Bass Memorial Endowment at Columbia Academy in honor and memory of their grandson who served as a U.S. Marine and lost his life in Iraq in service to our country. This endowment provides, in perpetuity, the funding for the American flag on the flagpole in front of Old Main. John Bass is a 1953 graduate of Columbia Military Academy, and his father was a football coach and athletic director at CMA. The flags provided are 10' by 19' and meet the standard for the United States Flag Code.
